Grade 2 – 6 Supply List

This list is based on what is needed for the year and takes into account lost items. If your child tends to lose a lot of things, or does a lot of extra coloring, some of these supplies may need to be replenished later in the year. Extra supplies are kept in the storage bins in the child's homeroom and are brought out as needed. Any unused items that are left over will be sent home in June and can be used again the following year.

Please ensure that all supplies/personal items are clearly labeled with your child's name (binders need to be labeled on the spines).

- running shoes for Phys Ed
- 1 pair of indoor shoes to stay at school (can be the running shoes)
- 1 backpack
- 1 water bottle
- 20 to 30 pencils
- 2 pencil sharpeners
- 5+ white erasers
- 1 ruler (30cm)
- 4x - 1" binders
- 1 package of binder dividers
- ½ package of lined paper
- 2 clipboards
- 1 pocket portfolio/folder (no prongs)
- 3 duotangs
- 1 pair of headphones – single prong jack (NEW)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 4+ glue sticks (large)
- 1 package of markers
- 4 highlighters – 4 different colors
- 1 package of colored pencils
- 1 pencil case – for carrying basic supplies from class to class (not coloring utensils)
- 1 pencil box – for coloring utensils
- 1 plastic storage container with lid – to hold extra supplies (not binders). No larger than 16"x13"x5" or 15qt/14.2

- 1 USB memory stick – non-retractable (gr. 2-3)
- 1 erasable ball point pen (gr. 3-4)
- 5+ erasable ball point pens (gr. 5-6)
- 1 small coil notebook or hard cover journal (gr. 4-6)
- laptop – recommended, not mandatory (as long as the student can be responsible to handle/care for it) (gr. 4-6)
- 1 sketch book

- 1 green (½ plain, ½ interlined)

- 2 yellow (½ plain, ½ ruled)

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Grade 7 - 12 Supply List

- pens
- pencils (2 boxes)
- graph paper
- lined paper
- erasers
- whiteout
- highlighters
- pencil sharpener
- scissors
- glue sticks
- markers and/or pencil crayons
- agenda/daytimer
- geometry set
- scientific calculator with Trig functions (TI – 30Xa recommended)(gr. 7 – 9)
- graphing calculator - TI brand recommended)(gr. 10 – 12)
- 1 binder with dividers OR separated binders for each subject OR coiled notebooks for each subject.
- appropriate supplies for note taking/work organizing are necessary.
- USB memory stick
- sketchbook/journal (around A4 size) (gr. 9)

- laptop or iPad (recommended – not mandatory. School is not responsible for loss or damage, and has the right to revoke laptop use)
- ruler

It is recommended that students have:

- gym strip (PE can take place at any point of the day, having antiperspirant or deodorant at the school is encouraged)
- water bottle
- headphones
- lock for their locker
